1- Champagne Moutard Grande Cuvée Btl £35
125ml £5.95

Fine, rich, developed nose with fragrances of butter, almond and brioche.

2- Champagne Moutard Prestige Rosé Btl £40

Delicate and elegant.

3- Prosecco di Conegliano Extra Dry DOCG Carpenè Malvolti, Italy Btl £23

A very fine and fruity bouquet, guaranteed to get you in the mood for a party.

4- Ondarre Cava Brut, Spain Btl £18

Apples, nut and marmite on the nose. A lively mousse, refreshing and green apple on the finish.

5 - Moet et Chandon, Rose Btl £65

The seductive champagne: lively, expressive, dominated by the scent of wild strawberries

6 - Perrier Jouet Belle Epoque Btl £115

Vintage 2002, France

The world famous hand-painted bottle, evocative as ever!

Red Wines

7 - Castelao, Portugal £15

Santo Isidro de Pegôes Red £3.95/£5.10

A flavoursome wine soft on the palate with suggestions of fresh raspberries and violets.

8 - Pinot Noir, Chile £18

Viña Edmara £4.60/£6.10

A rich, pure wine with raspberry fruit, rich pallet and an elegant lingering crispness.

9 - Carignan/ Grenache/ Syrah,

Cuvée Le Bosq Rouge, France £16

Fruity, light and easy drinking £4.10/£5.45
Southern French wine.

10 - Avaton, Greece £25

Domaine Gerovassiliou, Kavala

Stunningly good! Elegant, savoury, dry spicy nose showing earthy black fruits. Modern and fruity but with a lovely structure.

11 - Shiraz, Spain £16

Chispas, Covinca

Deep red colour, black pepper and violet aromas, firm, silky tannins on the palate, well structured with a fresh long berry finish.

12 - Valpolicella Superiore 'Ripasso',

Italy £27

Capitel San Rocco Rosso Tedeschi, Veneto

Made with grapes that have been slightly dried, this intense, full bodied red is a real treat. Beautiful wine from one of the finest producers in Italy.

14 - Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva,

Chile £21

Perez Cruz

Intense blackcurrants and eucalyptus on the nose, jammy fruits on the palate, velvety smooth tannins with a long, intense finish.

15 - Tempranillo/Garnacha, Spain

Rioja Crianza 'Rivallana' £21

Bodegas Ondarre

Powerful fruit aromas well-combined with hints of oak ageing. On the palate it reveals concentrated, ripe fruit flavours.

16 - Malbec, Argentina £19.50

Dona Paula

Violet colour, bouquet of plums, blackfruits and chocolate. Good structure with pleasant tannins on the palate, fresh fruit flavours and spice on the finish.

17 - Merlot/Raboso, Italy £14

Il Casone

A medium bodied, easy drinking red wine with berried fruit flavours and a lingering finish.

White Wines

18 - Cortese, Italy £22

Gavi de Gavi 'Fossili' San Silvestro, Piemonte

Made from the Cortese grape, the name Gavi di Gavi rolls off the tongue as easily as the wine rolls on!

19 - Riesling, France £23.50

Dopffau Moulin, Alsace

Fresh floral bouquet with the characteristic lemony liveliness of the Rhine Riesling grape variety. Crisp and bone dry on the palate, lively and refreshing with a touch of minerality.

20 - Fiorile Grecanico DOCG, Italy

Duca di Castelmonte, Sicily £16.50

Attractive pink in colour, the wine is fruity, very drinkable in style, with a clean finish.

21 - Verdejo, Spain £23.50

Villa Narcisa, Javier Sanz, Rueda

Verdejo is THE varietal in Spain. Young & lively, with a lovely crisp & lingering finish. Ask to see the cork too - it's worth keeping!

22 - Viura, Spain £19

Rioja Blanco 'Barrique Fermented', Ondarre

A delicious, balanced, fresh white Rioja made from the Viura grape

23- Muscadet, France £22

Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine Sur Lie, 'La Griffé' Chéreau Carré, Loire valley

Simply one of the best lunchtime wines. Superb with oysters, scallops & smoked salmon.

24 - Viognier, Chile £18

Viña Edmara

A full expression of the range, fruity, fresh and well balanced, very easy to drink.

25 - Alvarinho, Portugal £28

Reguengo de Melgaco, Minho

This maritime wine is full of citrus flavours and is sharp as they come. Try it with any seafood and you'll see what we mean!

26 - Godello Blanco, Spain £22

Finca OS Cobatos, Monterrei

Clean, pale straw colour, highly aromatic with fruity aromas and a mineral sensation. Crisp and dry on the palate with notes of pineapple and tropical fruits. Wonderful with shellfish.

27 - Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand

Faultline, Marlborough £20

Fresh and delicious with a delicate aroma of sweet honeysuckle, tropical fruits and a subtle hint of herbs.

28 - Sauvignon Blanc, South Africa

Southern Right, Hermanus £23.50

Wonderful balance of forward fruit and minerality with a generous complexity to complement the wine's natural varietal fruitiness.

29- Unwooded Chardonnay, Canada

Pelee Island, Ontario £24

An amazing & light Chardonnay, from one of Canada's finest producers, our version for 'Chablis'. Very eco-friendly, their vineyards are a haven to all sorts of wildlife.

30 - Garganega Chardonnay - Italy

Il Casone £14

An easy drinking, subtly scented, fresh and fruity wine with an attractive hint of almond in the background.

31 - Chardonnay/Arinto/Antão Vaz,

Portugal £21

Colheita Seleccionada Adega de Pegôes White, Portugal

Straw with lemon hints, a full flavoured wine, full bodied with a creamy vanilla oak character. One of our favourites!

32 - Garnacha, Spain £15

Chispas Rosado Covinca £3.95/ £5.10

This fun pink rose was produced by the Covinca Co-operative, an innovative team seeking to make quality wines with fresh flavours and finesse from the arid terrain of Cariñena. Great with prawns, langoustines & scallops.

33 - Syrah/Grenache Noir, France

Château de Campuget 'Invitation' £19.50

Rosé AC Costières de Nîmes

Intense peony pink with a very aromatic bouquet with scents of small red fruits such as raspberries and blackcurrants. In the mouth there is perfect balance between vivacity and mellowness.

34 - Zinfandel, California

Sunset Point Zinfandel Blush £16

This Californian Rosé wine has good structure and body with freshing acidity. Full flavours of chunky curranty fruit.

35 - Malagoussia, Greece

Domaine Gerovassiliou, Kavala £25

What can we say? It's Greek and £6.35/ £8.50
it's outstanding. Think Albarino - but much better. Try it and we're sure you'll love it!

36 - Colombard/ Ugni Blanc, France

Cuvée Le Bosq Blanc de Blanc £15.50

Fruity nose of citrus and passion £3.95/ £5.25
fruit, the wine has lovely fresh aromatics and a clean, well balanced freshness.

37 - Chenin Blanc, South Africa

Suikerbossie, Boer & Brit £18.50

Made by two friends, one of Boer £4.65/ £6.25
descent and one Brit, this is a great introduction to South African Chenin Blanc. Lovely fruit flavours balance well with a clean, slightly off-dry finish. One of our favourites!

38 - Pinot Grigio, Italy

Solazzo Premio IGT £17.50

A dry white wine with a mineral £4.45/ £5.90
character and a round and spicy flavour.

39 - Fernao Pires, Portugal

Fontanario de Pegôes White £17

Santo Isidro de Pegôes £4.35/ £5.75

Pale lemon with a grassy nose, citrus palate, medium body with crisp acidity and a refreshing clean finish.

40 - Sauvignon Blanc, Chile

Tierra Antica, Limari valley £17.50

Light and delicate yellow in colour, £4.45/ £5.90
with delicious aromas of melon, apple and grapefruit showing on the nose. The palate is equally as charismatic, with passion fruit and mineral characteristics appearing. Perfectly fresh and fruity.

41 - Grüner Veltliner, Austria

Weingut Rabl, Kamptal £20

A fine, fresh bouquet with lemon, £5.05/ £6.80
citrus and mineral tones on the palate through to a balanced and elegant finish.

42 - Unoaked Chardonnay, £18

Australia £4.60/ £6.10

Foundstone, Berton Vineyards

This unoaked Chardonnay offers lime, melon and lifted green apple aromas which give way to a clean, crisp palate with flavours of lime softened by honey dew melon which continues to a long and zesty finish.
